## **CLASS DETERMINATION San-E-Foam**

The Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines Group has completed a class determination for the above named product.

Based on the information submitted, this product has been determined not to be an agricultural compound, for the following reason(s):

San-E-Foam is a biocide which is intended for use as a cleaner and sanitiser for washing equipment and surfaces in factories, coolrooms, freezers, transport vehicles, shipping containers and livestock carriers. The label and advertising material do not indicate that the product will come into direct contact with primary produce, and therefore the product is not considered an agricultural compound. This product will not require registration under the ACVM Act 1997.

This class determination becomes invalid if:

- 1. This product is changed in any way.
- 2. This product is advertised using information different from that assessed in the process of this class determination.
- 3. Three years has elapsed since the date of this class determination.
- 4. You do not comply with the conditions stated in the ACVM Regulations 2001

This Class Determination letter must be presented to MAF Quarantine Services in order to release the above named product, if it is being imported.

Although the ACVM Group does not have regulatory interest in the product, you may still be required to comply with the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 and the Biosecurity Act 1993.
